As I write this article it still feels like summer outside. Hopefully soon we will see much cooler mornings and some point I'm sure fall will arrive and stay for a little while. This time of year brings its share of illnesses and germs. At Messiah Lambs we take precautions against these germs, but despite our best efforts we are sometimes unable to prevent them from being shared. Please help us keep our classrooms healthy by following these simple steps: 1) Please help your children with hand washing procedures at home. We wash our hands every time we enter the classroom, after using the restroom and before and after eating. Washing at home will reinforce this practice and become a good habit. 2) If your child has a temperature of 100 degrees or higher without medication in their system, you must keep them home from school. Your child may return to school when they have remained fever free without medication for 24 hours. 3) If your child is vomiting or has diarrhea please keep them home from school until they have remained symptom free for 24 hours.

4) If your child must take medication, please remember to sign it in at the office. No medication may remain in a child's backpack.5) If your child becomes ill while in our care we will call you and ask you to make arrangements to come and get your child as soon as possible. Thank you for your help in keeping our students and staff healthy this year.
