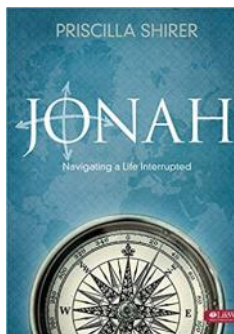


Mid-Week Bible Study Opportunities

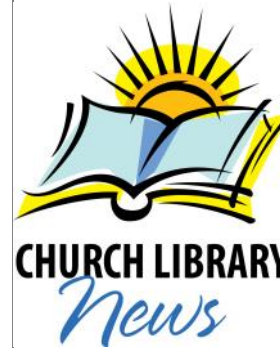

Currently under construction, the Discovery Center for Science and Earth History is located in Dallas, 1830 Royal Lane (Royal Lane and Luna). This creation museum "will cover a variety of topics where science and the Bible meet: like the origins of the universe, Noah and the flood, the Garden of Eden and other Biblical timelines." (WFAA) It is being designed by scientists who are Christians and who give our Great Triune God the credit for

all creation, using biblical reference. The museum will include an animatronic dinosaur, a planetarium, and educational materials for Christian schools and homeschoolers.
