A Word From Pastor Lee

The Small Catechism

The word "advent" is from the Latin word for "coming." It describes the "coming" of our Lord Jesus Christ, as He came into our world. As we continue with our Introduction to the Explanation of the Small Catechism, we find that, after answering "Who is Jesus Christ?" we now look at what God has done for us. Question 3 (page 44) says, "What has this one God done?" The answer is this: "God made all things and loves His creation, especially His human creatures. Beginning with our first parents, all humanity has rebelled against Him and fallen into darkness, sin, and death. God the Father sent His only son into the world to become man and to redeem and save humanity by His death

and resurrection. God sent His Spirit so that people might once again be His own through faith in His Son, Jesus, who is the world's "only hope, life, and salvation."

This is supported by the following Bible passages:

John 3:16 – For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

THE ADVENT WREATH

Candles more and more have come to symbolize Christ as the light of the world. The use of candles In the Advent season, lighting another each week, is symbolic of the approaching coming of Christ. The increasing light reminds us that His presence draws closer. The intensity of light builds to a climax on Christmas Eve.

The circular wreath is a symbol of the continuing and eternal presence of God. The Evergreens symbolize everlasting life. There is no universal tradition for the color or names of the candles. When purple candles are used they symbolize penitence and forgiveness. A pink rose candle, symbolic of joy, is sometimes lit during the third week.

Suggested themes for the four candles which will be celebrated in our church worship services are: the PROMISE of the prophets that the Messiah would come; the WAITING for the Messiah; the PEACE we find in Christ who is the Prince of Peace; and the HOPE we find In Christ. If you choose to put a white Christ candle in the center of your wreath, it should be lit on Christmas Eve to show that the wait is over! Jesus Christ, the promised Prince of Peace, is born!

AN ORDER FOR FAMILY PRAYER

One member lights candles.

All: sing "O Come, O Come Emmanuel"

Vs l. Oh, come, oh, come, Emmanuel, And ransom captive Israel,
That mourns in lonely exile here
Until the Son of God appear.
Rejoice! Rejoice! Emmanuel
Shall come to you, O Israel!

Leader: (Read devotion for the day.)

One of family: (May lead in the prayers each day or all may join in saying.."Our Father, who art in heaven..")

Leader: May the Lord Bless us all, keep us from sin, and lead us to heaven. Amen. (Extinguish candles.)
